Old Business:

- NOAC/Momentum Update
 - o Momentum (in person) canceled
 - Encouraged to attend Momentum: Launch
 - Refunds:
 - NOAC only: should have received check via mail
 - Momentum: plus or minus 14 days to receive by mail (coming in August check run)
 - 15 fundraiser patches still available (5 blue and 10 red)
 - Sell or keep?
 - Selling would fundraise an additional \$75.
 - The money would carry over to the fundraising for NOAC 2022
 - General consensus is to sell patches
 - Patches still sold by Will Richards

- Motion: "to close the discussion." Chris B.

 - Motion carries
- Motion: "to sell the remaining patches." Chris B.
 - Motion carries
- LLD
 - Still want to hold LLD in person
 - o Gathering mandate limits groups to a maximum of 50 people
 - New \$150 cleaning/sanitizing fee at Denbigh Christian Academy in order to use their spaces
 - Problem is finding a venue
 - LLD cannot be outdoors (as evidenced by trainings at 2019 Conclave)
 - Some want to see the LLD go virtual
 - Our Zoom package (Zoom Pro):
 - Allows host to split meeting into break-out groups
 - Allows for unlimited meeting time
 - Attendee cap is 300
 - Starting a conversation with Fred (not in attendance)
 - o LLD needs to be held this year
 - Mr. MacDonald suggests an in-person venue on the South Side
 - No sanitation fee
 - Need to clean up after ourselves
 - Suggest bringing in speakers via Zoom call on TVs at venue
 - o Appeal to getting older scouts (at school) using Zoom
 - Pay \$5 and get a patch

New Business:

 - Promote at chapter meetings
- Event Update
 - August Service Weekend has been canceled
 - Still hoping to gather for Summer Service (September 11 13, 2020)
- Virtual Chapter Meetings
 - Lodge Chief wants chapters meeting virtually to maintain contact to keep members involved and active
- Holiday Banquet
 - Kecoughtan volunteered to take-over the banquet at June LEC
 - Differ to Kecoughtan leadership
 - Due to uncertainties, Kecoughtan has decided to hold the Holiday Banquet virtually
 - No venue could commit
 - Winter Banquet is the second Saturday
 - Unless someone can find a guaranteed venue, Holiday Banquet 2020 is virtual
- Chapter Pages for Website
 - Ultimate goal is to make the website a one-stop-shop for all news and information from the Lodge and the chapters
 - Attached at the bottom of the minutes is the template for the new Chapter Pages (design on the left, notes on the right)
 - All chapters start out with the same design as the template

- Woodbadge
 - Woodbadge planning is still going forward
 - Held on two weekends: 16-18 October and 7-8 November, 2020
 - Day 4 usually involves youth

 - Wanted: participation by Lodge members (at least one youth per chapter)
 - Working on youth transportation to Gilwell Field
 - Great opportunity for service hours
 - Chance to spotlight the OA to Scouters
 - Event falls under the Council Events Support committee
 - Ashleigh S. to contact committee
- Vigil
 - Item 1: Patch
 - Patch is a handout at selection committee, Vigil Weekend, and to the new Vigil nominees
 - For Vigil Weekend, patches are awarded for either effort or cash, with effort taking priority
 - Approval needed for design (Thank you Mr. Locke!)
 - General consensus, like the design
 - Motion: "to approve the vigil patch" Parker M.
 - Motion carries
 - o Item 2: Nomination Committee meeting location
 - Nominations are due before August 15 (see website)
 - Know that selections will be in the morning (9 AM 12 Noon)
 - Do not know where or how the selections will take place
 - Where:
 - In person at Pipsico Scout Reservation
 - No cost
 - Use any of the buildings/spaces
 - Online via Zoom
 - o Technicians room at Dave Turner's office
 - Enforced maximum of 14 people
 - Vigil Weekend is 14-15 of November
 - Preference is to hold the selections live
 - Pipsico or the Technicians room
 - Nominations:
 - Submissions sent to the Scout Office before August 15
 - Filling out the form is not required but is highly encouraged
 - Eligible for Vigil if Brotherhood was earned at or before Spring Service Weekend of 2018
 - Need two or more <u>youth</u> representatives from each chapter at selection committee who are not eligible for nomination
 - Youth can be representatives if they <u>have not</u> been Brotherhood for two or more years OR if they are Vigil


