

The Kecoughtan collection of David McCurdy donated to Alibamu Lodge 179 and sold via Facebook by Mike D Bazonis has been purchased with the approval of the Wahunsenakah 333 History Committee and the recommendation per Zachary Omen via Telecom to obtain the collection with the intention of obtain additional required monies to be voted on and approved by the LEC.

This purchase adds about fifty nine (59) lodge issues not currently held by the lodge.

The agreed buying price of \$2,200.00 was at the high end of the History Committees target value and is \$1,300.00 less than the original asking price of \$3,500.00.
