

## **Camp Lions Driving Guidelines**

This guideline is to explain the new Rules put out by Tidewater Council on driving while in Camp Lions. Tidewater had a gate installed between the Burton building and the medical building. This gate is operated by remote and by a code. The code will not be given out. The purpose of the gate is to keep nonessential vehicles out of the Camp Lion's area. The following vehicles will have access to the Camp Lions camp area.

- Service Advisors vehicle.
- Medics vehicle
- Approved Service vehicles by Service Advisors. (During service hours)
- Trading post Advisor to drop off merchandise (Will Park behind Kitchen)
- Engraving Team truck and Trailer (Will Park behind Kitchen)
- Ceremonies team will have access prior to any ceremonies to drop off Equipment and return to parking lot at completion of drop off.
- Kitchen crew that arrives prior to the ordeal starting at 5 pm.

**For any vehicle that is past the gate they are REQUIRED by BSA and Tidewater to have a Fire Extinguisher and a First Aid kit in vehicle.**

- **Speed limit is 5 mph.**
- **Hazard lights, headlights and if equipped yellow strobe lights.**
- **No parking or driving on the grass unless required**
- **Parking is only allowed behind kitchen and main parking lot.**

Access to the camp will **NOT** be granted to drop off personal equipment at camp sites. Pipsico provides carts to transport personal belongings. Safety is the priority to Camp Pipsico, Tidewater Council, and Colonial Virginia Council.
