**Instructions for Vigil Honor Nomination Form** 

- 1. Provide nominee's name.
- 2. List nominee's date of birth (if known)
- 3. List Ordeal date (if known)
- 4. List Brotherhood date (if known).
- 5. Give the nominee's current primary registered Scouting position.
- 6. List all OA positions which the individual has held or currently holds, (i.e. chapter/lodge officer, chapter committee chairman or associate chairman, chapter/lodge adviser or associate adviser, Conclave committee chair/adviser, etc.). If no positions were held, leave blank. Chapter/lodge positions are not mandatory for Vigil Honor selection.
- 7. List all other Scouting positions previously held or currently holding excluding the positions listed in (5) and (6) above.
- 8. List all Scouting awards received (i.e. Eagle Scout, Venturing Awards, District Award of Merit, Silver Beaver, Wood Badge, etc.)
- 9. **Thoroughly** list the qualifications of the nominee to receive the Vigil Honor as outlined in the OA Handbook. Primary attention should be given to the Lodge, Chapter, Unit and Camp. Use extra paper if necessary. **Remember, the Vigil selection committee is unlikely to know your nominee as well as you do—providing complete and thorough information is important to the nomination process.**
- 10. List any OA and Scouting leadership development opportunities attended at a local, sectional, regional or national level (LLD, Conclaves, NLS, NLATS, NCLS, NYLT, Philmont Training Center, etc.).
- 11. List any non-Scouting related service that should be considered in evaluating the nominee.
- 12. List your phone number, the current date, and sign the nomination form.
